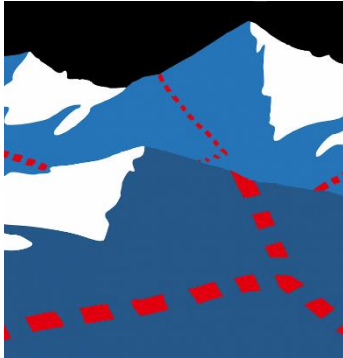


The war over Nagorno-Karabakh

For nearly seven weeks Armenians and Azerbaijanis have been at war for the region of Nagorno-Karabakh. Should the anew negotiated ceasefire fail, the conquest of the entire region by Azerbaijan cannot be ruled out. At least 90,000 Armenians have already fled Nagorno-Karabakh and the neighboring areas previously occupied by Armenians. At the same time, more than 600,000 Azerbaijanis who fled Nagorno-Karabakh 30 years ago are waiting for their return. What options are there for the future of Nagorno Karabakh and its inhabitants? And who claims to have a say in the negotiation processes?
